Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted that your son will be starting Bullers Wood School for Boys this September. In the interim, I wish to provide you with an information update including some key dates for your diaries.

## Planning and Site

The ESFA and Contractor are consulting with the Trust on the plans for the layout and refurbishment of 1 Westmoreland Road. A number of us have visited the site and are satisfied that there will be space for our intake of Year 7 boys. We are also confident that, with careful timetabling, we will have the facilities and resources to deliver our curriculum.

On the day of our visit, we were also reassured that boys will be able to access the site safely by using the pedestrian controlled crossings on both the High Street and Westmoreland Road. We hope to be in a position to share internal plans for this building shortly.

An appeal relating to the refusal of the second planning application for the permanent building at St Hugh's is about to be lodged and a third planning application is being prepared. These plans will also be shared with you at a future consultation event.

## Staffing

We have already begun to recruit, with the majority of posts due to be advertised immediately after Easter. Once appointed, we will upload pen portraits of our staff on to our website.

## Uniform

We are updating our uniform and liaising with a number of companies to ensure that our supplier provides 'best value' and an efficient ordering and supply system for parents. We will provide more information including a full uniform list next term.

## Lunchtime Arrangements

We think that we will be able to provide some form of hot food during lunchtimes at 1 Westmoreland Road – this will be in the form of pasta pots and paninis.

## PE & Sport

We are continuing to investigate a variety of options to ensure that we can deliver high quality PE lessons and an extra-curricular sporting offer.

Our SENCO will be available at our Further Information Event on **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> June** (please see the table below). She will be based in the Library and will be on hand to speak to you and your son and respond to any queries you may have.

## Primary School Visits

After May half term, we will be visiting your son in his primary school setting. This will be his opportunity to meet with us and to ask us any questions that he may have about starting secondary school with us in September.
